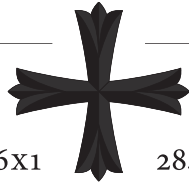

LENTEN MISSION

“The Catholic Faith is Such It Can be Taught to a Child”: Jesus tells us in the Gospel that “his yoke is easy and his burden light. Does it seem to you that the Roman Catholic Faith is complicated? It seems to me that there is an attitude that our Faith is complicated, and you almost need a doctorate in order to understand it or live it. It’s not true. Come to the mission and hear more. Father Beachey will give the talks.

March 31, April 1, and April 2 beginning at 6:30 pm with Confessions available. Exposition, Adoration, Talk, Night Prayer and Benediction beginning at 7:00 pm at the Cathedral.

“In Persona Christi”: At Mass, the priest acts “in persona Christi”, i.e., in the person of Christ. Of course, the Mass is a ritual action and not theatre. Some may wonder why the priest looks down during the Mass rather than engaging people with gestures or even his eyes. This is the reason, it is Christ who, through the ministerial priesthood, transforms the bread and wine into His Body and Blood.

Stations of the Cross: Every Friday during Lent, the Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 7:00 pm at the Cathedral. You are also encouraged to pray them yourself before Mass or anytime. Simply say: The first station, the Condemnation” etc., and an Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be for each station.

Different Readings at 10:30 am Mass: The Church uses a three-year cycle of readings. We call them, Year A, Year B and Year C. This year we are in the Year C cycle. However, when we celebrate the scrutinies for the RCIA, we always use the readings from Year A. This is why you will notice that your missalette has different readings than the ones you will hear at the 10:30 am Mass.
