

## COMMON ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Holy Week Begins:** With Palm Sunday the Christian world enters its most holy time of the year. This is when we celebrate and remember what God has done for us through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. It should be a time of deep devotion, penance and thanksgiving. We are to be full of joy at the rising of our Lord and God. Let's take this week serious – especially the celebration of the Easter Triduum. These three days constitute the most holy time of the year. Beginning with Holy Thursday, then Good Friday and the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday. This should be the priority for the Catholic for this coming week. Let's make a good Easter.

**The Mass of Chrism:** How fortunate are we in Pembroke to have a Chrism Mass each year to attend! Growing up in a small town so far from the Peterborough Cathedral, I never had the opportunity to attend the Chrism Mass until I was in the seminary. The Holy Oils for the Sick and the Catechumens are blessed and the Sacred Chrism is consecrated by the bishop. These Holy Oils will be used throughout the year in baptisms, confirmations and the anointing of the sick. If you are able to attend, please join our bishops and priests from around the diocese as they renew their commitment to their priestly ministry.

**GOOD FRIDAY IS A UNIVERSAL DAY OF FAST AND ABSTINENCE:** **Fasting:** The Church requires all Catholics from ages 14-59 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means that you should only eat one full meal, plus two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal. **Abstinence:** Catholics age 14 and older do not eat meat on Good Friday. Those with health issues (e.g., diabetes, etc) are exempt from the rule of fasting.

**Confessions:** There will be confessions after all the Masses today. As well, there will be confessions from 10:00 am until 10:30 am on **Good Friday at Holy Name** and from 2:30 pm until 3:00 pm on **Good Friday at the Cathedral**. Confessions will also be available on the Wednesday of Holy Week, April 16th at **Our Lady of Lourdes Church, Pembroke** from 2:00pm-4:00pm and from 6:00pm-7:00pm. Visiting priests available.

**Adoration after Holy Thursday:** Will you spend an hour with the Lord? After the Masses of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, parishioner of Cathedral and Holy Name are welcomed to spend an hour (or whatever time you can give) in adoration. This adoration will take place at Holy Name's Resurrection Chapel for Cathedral and Holy Name Parishioners.

**Blessing of the Easter Food:** Those who wish to have their Easter food blessed may gather at the Cathedral on Saturday morning at 11:00 am. Father Peter will bless the food in Polish and Father Beachey in English and Spanish.
