


Month of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus: June is the month when we honour and reflect on the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The heart representing the love of God for each and every human person. The Heart that was wounded for our sins so that we might live eternally.

Feast of St. Columbkille: This Monday, June 9th is the Feast day of St. Columbkille, the patron saint of our Diocese and the patron Saint of the Cathedral. Bishop Brehl will celebrate Mass at 12:30 pm at the Cathedral. At the end of this Mass, Bishop Brehl will impart the Apostolic Blessing. Attached to this blessing is a plenary indulgence requiring we are free from mortal sin, have detachment from worldly things and we say and Our Father, a Hail Mary and a Glory Be for the intentions of Pope Leo XIV for this month. Adoration will take place after the Mass until 4:00 pm where Vespers will be sung and ending then with Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament.
