

### SAINT FOR THIS WEEK: ST. ALPHONSUS LIGUORI



Educated originally as a lawyer, St. Alphonsus received the call hearing an inner voice saying to him: "Leave the world and give yourself to me." He founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, the Redemptorists, an order to which our Bishop was a member. They are best known in Canada for their missions to the parishes. St. Alphonsus is also known as the Moral Doctor of the Church for his writings in Moral Theology. He was born Sept 27, 1696; ordained a priest Dec 21, 1726; Consecrated a bishop June 20 1762. He died Aug 1, 1787 and canonized a saint on May 26, 1839. He is the patron saint of confessors, vocations, arthritis, lawyers and moral theologians. His feast day is this Friday, August 1, the day of his death.
