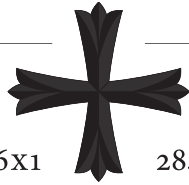

### **SAINT FOR THIS WEEK: ST. JEAN-MARIE VIANNEY**

St. Jean-Marie Vianney, the cure of Ars in France (8 May 1786 – 4 Aug 1849). He is the patron saint of parish priests. He was canonized May 1, 1925. He was known for his preaching and for being a confessor. So renowned was he as a confessor that near the end of his life he would spend up to 16 hours a day in the confessional as people came from all over.
