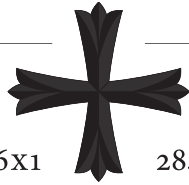

**Thanksgiving Weekend:** The Parish Offices will be closed on Monday, October 13<sup>th</sup>, and will reopen on Tuesday, October 14<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am.

If you would like to register to make your Sunday offerings through Electronic Debiting, or if you would like to find out more about this method of donation, please contact the parish office.

**All Souls' Day:** November 2<sup>nd</sup> is the Commemoration of the Faithful Departed. In your envelope boxes, you will find an envelope for All Souls' Day where you can place the names of your deceased loved ones to be remembered at our Masses. If there is not enough space on the envelope, you can add more names on a separate piece of paper and put it into the envelope. If you wish, you may give a donation of money and put it in the envelope as well. The money received will be turned into Mass Intentions that will appear in the bulletin as "Holy Souls in Purgatory". The names will also be placed in a book that will be in the sanctuary of each church throughout the month of the Holy Souls. If you do not have an envelope for All Souls', this includes those enrolled in the pre-authorized debit (EFT) giving program, there are some available in the churches or you can use your own envelope. Please include your name and address if you require a receipt.
