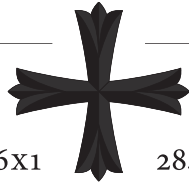

Pope's Prayer Intention for November 2025: For the prevention of suicide – Let us pray that those who are tempted to commit suicide might find the support, care and love they need in their community, and be open to the beauty of life.

Should I have a Funeral Mass? Many times, I am surprised when a practicing Roman Catholic opts to have no Funeral Mass when they die. I am not sure of all the reasons, and they are probably individual. However, I encourage Roman Catholics to witness to their faith – even in death – by ensuring that a Funeral Mass is offered. One may have to tell his or her children of their desire to have a Funeral Mass. The Funeral Mass does not need to be a large affair. You can have a Funeral Mass with as few or as many people as you want. The Funeral Mass express our belief in the Resurrection of Jesus for it is the Sacrifice of the Cross. Roman Catholics should have a Funeral Mass. The Church prefers that the body be present, and cremation (if used) happens after the Funeral Mass. However, you can have a Mass in the Presence of Cremated Remains with burial after the Mass.

Importance of Praying for the Dead: As we know that Purgatory is a place where many souls go to remove any attachments to the world so that the soul is ready to enter into the heavenly kingdom, we have a solemn obligation to offer up prayers and sacrifices for the those who have died. This prayer is from St. Gertrude:
Eternal Father, I offer Thee the Most Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with the masses said throughout the world today, for all the holy souls in purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal church, those in my own home and within my family. Amen.

Book of Remembrance: Our Book of Remembrance will be placed in the Church this week and will remain there until the end of November so that all parishioners may inscribe in it the names of their beloved deceased.

Saturday Morning Mass: Saturday morning Mass will begin this Saturday at 10:00 am and will continue so long as there is a response from the laity. Please remember that this Mass does not fulfill your Sunday obligation. If you do not use it, you will lose it.

Mass for Persecuted Christians: Red Wednesday, November 19, 2025, is the annual mass for those Christians who are Persecuted throughout the world. Pope Leo XIV has stated: *“our world continues to witness rising hostility and violence against those who hold different convictions, including many Christians. In contrast, your mission proclaims that, as one family in Christ, we do not abandon our persecuted brothers and sisters. Rather, we remember them, we stand with them, and we labour to secure their God-given freedoms.”* If you are able, you are encouraged to wear red this day. Christian persecution is very real. Before 2003, there were 1.5 million Christians in Iraq. Today it is between 150,000 and 200,000. Mass at the Cathedral will be at 7:00 pm this day.
