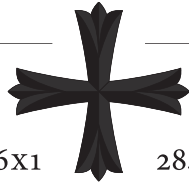

St. John Lateran: The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the Cathedral church of the Diocese of Rome. Therefore, it is the cathedral of the Pope and his cathedra (or chair) is located in this Cathedral. Therefore, it is the mother church of the entire Roman Catholic Church. As such, the anniversary of its dedication on November 9, 324 AD by Pope Sylvester I, is celebrated throughout the world demonstrating our union with the Holy Father.

Saturday Morning Mass: Saturday morning Masses at 10:00 am will continue so long as there is a response from the laity. Please remember that this Mass does not fulfill your Sunday obligation. If you do not use it, you will lose it.

Bible Study: Please note that there will **not** be a Bible Study with Fr Peter this Thursday, November 13. We will continue with session five on Thursday, November 20, at 6:30pm in the Cathedral basement.

Mass for Persecuted Christians: Red Wednesday, November 19, 2025, is the annual mass for those Christians who are Persecuted throughout the world. Pope Leo XIV has stated: “*our world continues to witness rising hostility and violence against those who hold different convictions, including many Christians. In contrast, your mission proclaims that, as one family in Christ, we do not abandon our persecuted brothers and sisters. Rather, we remember them, we stand with them, and we labour to secure their God-given freedoms.*” If you are able, you are encouraged to wear red this day. Christian persecution is very real. Before 2003, there were 1.5 million Christians in Iraq. Today it is between 150,000 and 200,000. Mass at the Cathedral will be at 7:00 pm this day.

Book of Remembrance: Our Book of Remembrance will be placed in the Church this week and will remain there until the end of November so that all parishioners may inscribe in it the names of their beloved deceased.
