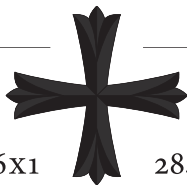

**Mass Times for Christmas: Holy Name:** Christmas Eve at 4:15 pm and Christmas Day at 10:30 am.

**Cathedral:** Christmas Eve at 5:15 pm. Midnight Mass at 12:00 Midnight and Christmas Day at 10:30 am.

**Candidacy and the Ministry of Lector:** Mr. Felix Ugo and Mr. Chris Kuehl will receive Candidacy from Bishop Brehl on December 21, 2025, at the 10:30 am Mass. Felix will also receive the ministry of lector at this Mass. These are short ceremonies that will take place after the homily.

**What is Candidacy?** At one time there was tonsure which today corresponds to candidacy. With tonsure, the bishop would clip some hair off the seminarian. It was at this time that the young man would be considered a cleric and dawn the soutane. After the Second Vatican Council this was changed to Candidacy wherein the seminarian makes a commitment to his journey towards ordination.

**What is the Ministry of Lector?** Once again, there were several minor orders prior to Vatican II. There was porter, lector, exorcist, acolyte and one can include the subdiaconate. None of these orders are of divine origin like the diaconate, the priesthood and the episcopacy. These were changed to Lector and Acolyte. These orders must be received in preparation for ordination.

**School Masses this Week:** Please note the change in Mass times for this Tuesday, December 16. The Cathedral Mass will be at 9:45 am and Holy Name will be at 10:30 am so that the school children can attend an Advent Mass.

**Rorate Masses:** Parishes in the Pembroke area will celebrate Masses in honour of the Virgin Mary on each Saturday of Advent, celebrated by candlelight before dawn. the final Rorate Mass will be December 20, 6:30 a.m. at St Joseph Parish, Allumette Island.

**Please Welcome Father Alexander MacDonald:** Father MacDonald is residing now at the Cathedral House. He hails from Arisaig, Nova Scotia originally and was ordained a priest in 2018 for the Archdiocese of Toronto. He is currently on loan to the Military Diocese and has been appointed the chaplain of CFB Petawawa.
