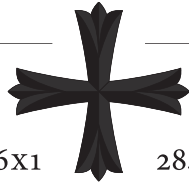

SOVEREIGN'S MEDAL FOR VOLUNTEERS – DEACON ADRIEN CHAPUT

Her Excellency the Right Honourable Mary Simon, Governor General of Canada, has awarded the Sovereign's Medal for Volunteers to Deacon Adrien Chaput for his tireless efforts on behalf of those most vulnerable in our community, especially in respect to his work and leadership with The Society of Saint Vincent DePaul and The Grind. To honour his work, there will be a medal presentation in the Parish Hall, on Sunday, January 11th at 12 Noon (after Mass).
