

## COMMON ANNOUNCEMENTS



St. Agnes of Rome was born in 291 AD and raised in a Christian family. Her love for the Lord was great and she hated sin even more than death! She died a virgin-martyr at the age of 12 or 13 on 21 January 304. Agnes was buried beside the Via Nomentana in Rome. Her bones are currently conserved beneath the high altar in the church of Sant'Angese fuori le mura in Rome, which was built over the catacomb that held her tomb. Her skull is preserved in the church of Sant'Agnese in Agone in Rome's Piazza Navona.
