

St. Thomas Aquinas was a Dominican friar, a theologian and philosopher and Doctor of the Church. He is known as the Angelic Doctor as he is the most influential writer and theologian in the Church. He lived from 1225 – 1274 in Italy. As a student, he was shy and quiet, barely speaking.
