PARISH MEETING FOR THOSE WHO ATTENDED THE DIOCESAN MEETING: The bishop has asked each parish to have a meeting to answer the following questions after having attended the Diocesan meeting this past Thursday. Here are the questions:

1. What did you hear at the Regional Deanery Meeting? Please share how this information affects you, and please listen to one another carefully.
2. In the short term, the diminishing number of active priests will necessitate some interim decisions to address the situation of the Diocese. Please reflect on the pastoral, financial, and building status of your parish. What do you think you can change or adapt in your parish community/parish cluster to begin to respond to these circumstances?
3. As you consider the longer-term plans for our Diocese, do you have any proposals, suggestions, or considerations which will help the Bishop and the Steering Committee in guiding the process of pastoral planning?

The number 40: The Israelites were in the desert for 40 years, the rain fell on the earth for 40 days and nights when Noah went into the Ark, King David ruled for 40 years. Jesus goes into the desert for 40 years and Lent is 40 days. When Jesus rises from the dead, he is on the earth for forty days. However, in these periods of 40 days, or years there is a change. The number symbolizes new growth, new life, transformation. From the 40 days of trial or testing something new arrives, something transforms. Lent comes from a Middle English word meaning 'springtime'. In Canada, we get to witness the change from winter to spring as new life grows green around us after the barren cold winter. Jesus gives us new and eternal life. Something indeed has changed and it is our salvation.

Lenten Faith Study: Fr Peter will be leading a faith study this Lent. We will be watching and discussing Bishop Robert Barron's six-part video series *The Mass*. This series will help you understand how to fully, consciously, and actively participate in the source and summit of the Christian life. We will be meeting weekly on Thursdays at 6:30pm in the Cathedral basement, beginning on February 26. All are welcome!
