

St. Blaise is known to many Catholics because of the blessing of the throats on his feast day or close to it. He was a physician and then became a doctor of souls. St. Blaise was beaten and iron combs were used to tear up his flesh. For this reason, many depictions of St. Blaise show him hold an iron comb. The candles come from the story that a woman brought him two fine candles to lighten up the gloom of his prison. He was eventually beheaded giving him the crown of martyrdom. He died in 316 AD.
