

COMMON ANNOUNCEMENTS

MASS FOR VICTIMS, FAMILY AND THE COMMUNITY OF TUMBLER RIDGE, BC: Bishop Brehl will celebrate Mass for the victims, the families of the victims and the entire community of Tumbler Ridge, BC as they try to cope from this horrible tragedy. The Mass will be on Monday, February 16, 2026 at 4:00 pm at St. Columbkille Cathedral. All are invited.

Family Day: Please note that the Parish Offices will be closed on Monday, February 16th, and will reopen on Tuesday, February 17th at 9:00 am.

Ash Wednesday begins the annual season of penance in preparation for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery at Easter. The three practices of Lent are fasting, prayer and almsgiving. Catholics are asked to fast and abstain from meat every Friday of the year (although this can be replaced with an act of charity or a pious activity except Ash Wednesday and Good Friday). Extra prayers each day such as attending Weekday Masses or adding to one's prayers each day and attending the Stations of the Cross Friday evenings. Almsgiving to the poor through the Lenten Development Collection or the Collection for Local Needs or other charities.

Ash Wednesday is a Universal Day of Fast and Abstinence: For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. Medical conditions such as diabetes are reasons to ignore the fasting requirements.

Masses for Ash Wednesday: These are scheduled below but note that there is also Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes at 8:00 am and 4:15 pm.

Rite of Election and Acceptance of Those to be Received into the Faith at St. Columbkille Cathedral: Bishop Michael Brehl will celebrate Mass at St. Columbkille Cathedral on the **1st Sunday of Lent, February 22, 2026, at 10:30 a.m.** The Mass the Rite of Election are for those to be baptized this Easter Vigil as well as the Acceptance of Candidates who will be confirmed and received into the Faith. Everyone preparing for baptism and reception into the Church throughout the Diocese are invited to participate with our Bishop at this Mass. Bishop Brehl and members of the diocesan steering committee will present relevant pastoral, statistical and financial data to help equip parishioners in ongoing dialogue and discernment on the future of the diocese.
