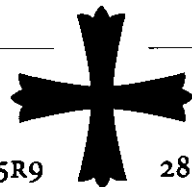

A container will be placed in each church so that you can bring old branches, place them in the container, and we will burn them. Mass of Chrism: Mass of Chrism will be celebrated by the Most Reverend Michael Brehl, C.Ss.R. on the **Tuesday of Holy Week, 31 March 2026** at the Cathedral of St. Columbkille at 10:30am. A reception will follow in the Cathedral Hall. All are welcome.

GOOD FRIDAY IS A UNIVERSAL DAY OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE – Good Friday is required day of fasting and abstinence. **All Catholics over the age of 14** are expected to abstain from the eating of meat on **Good Friday**. Those **ages 18 - 59** must **fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. On such days, those fasting may eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength. However, together, the smaller meals should not equal a full meal. As usual, there are exceptions for those who are frail, pregnant, diabetic, etc.

Divine Mercy Sunday: We invite all parishioners to join us in praying the **Novena to the Divine Mercy**, beginning on **Good Friday, April 3, 2026**, and concluding on **Divine Mercy Sunday, April 12, 2026**. With our celebration on that day beginning at 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. Our presenter will be Father Réal Ouellette. There will be Adoration, singing of Hymns and the Divine Mercy Chaplet as we pray for God's mercy upon the whole world. **Instructions:** The **Novena** consists of praying the **Divine Mercy Chaplet** each day for nine consecutive days with a special intention revealed to St. Faustina. Prayer pamphlets are available for you to take home. Let us prepare our hearts to receive the abundant graces promised by Jesus on this great feast of His Mercy. **"Jesus, I trust in You!" Have Mercy on us and on the whole world".**

Faith Study: There will be no faith study this week. The faith study, covering Bishop Barron's *The Mass*, will resume on **Thursday, April 16**. As this will be the last session, we will be having a potluck starting at 5:45 pm. All are invited to bring a dish and join us. The session will begin, as usual, at 6:30pm.

Confessions: After the Sunday's masses there will be confessions available. **Confessions will also be available at Our Lady of Lourdes Church on Sunday, March 29th from 2:00 PM until 4:00 PM** with several priests available.
