Divine Mercy Sunday: You are invited to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet on Sunday April 12, 2026, 2:00 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. at St. Columbkille Cathedral Parish 188 Renfrew Street Pembroke. Low Sunday (2nd Sunday of Easter): The traditional name of this Sunday is Low Sunday. The new calendar uses the term "Second Sunday of Easter" but Pope St. John Paul II designated it as the Sunday to celebrate the Divine Mercy of Jesus Christ towards all of us. It is an expression of His love for all his creation.

A week of Sundays: The octave of Easter, that is the days following Easter Sunday until the 2nd Sunday of Easter can be called a week of Sundays.
