**Annex Update.** The Foodbank has recently secured approval from the City's Severance Board to proceed with the purchase of the Annex and the necessary land, inclusive of the garage, conditional on the completion of stated obligations. Several weeks ago, the Parish agreed to allow the Foodbank to start their desired transformation of the Parish garage into their new food reception and storage area inclusive of walk-in fridge and freezers and a new utilities room for heat and hydro. This work is proceeding well. It is expected that this sale transaction will be concluded over the next several months. The final sale signed agreement ensures the continued Parish access to both the Annex and Kitchen for parish functions, subject to the Foodbank's distribution times. In addition, the Foodbank will cover the costs of a new Parish equipment storage shed that we will be installing in the coming weeks in the alcove between the rectory and the main entrance to the Sacristy. All funds generated from this Annex sale will be retained by the Parish to address future needs as they arise.
