### **St. Eugène of Mazenod**

St. Eugène of Mazenod was the founder of the Oblates of Mary Immaculate (OMI). He lived in France and became the bishop of Marseilles. In 1841, Bishop Bourget of Montréal invited the Oblates to his diocese. The Oblates have been active in the Pembroke Diocese since its beginnings. They were the founders of the Mattawa Parish as well as Temiscaming. Father Nédélec in Mattawa took to the rivers 21 times to visit the Native settlements along the way to James Bay. Today, the Polish Oblates look after St. Mary Parish, Wilno; St. Casimir Parish, Round Lake Centre and St. Hedwig Parish in Barry's Bay. Father Nédélec and other missionaries in our Diocese were in fact ordained priests by St. Eugène de Mazenod.
