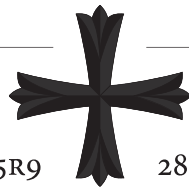

COMMON ANNOUNCEMENTS

Is ordinary time Ordinary? The translation from the Latin doesn't seem to work in English. There is nothing ordinary about the celebration of the Mass. The season of Ordinary Time appears after the Epiphany and then again after Pentecost. The vestments are usually green. One could argue that the seasons of the Roman Calendar represent specific times in the life of Jesus Christ. Advent focuses on the coming of Jesus, born at Bethlehem. Christmas on the birth of Jesus. Lent is a penitential season that prepares us for the Easter. Easter, of course, is that time we celebrated the Resurrection of Jesus and our Redemption. Ordinary Time, therefore, can be describe as the time that Jesus walked among us teaching, healing and preparing us for the great sacrifice of Himself.

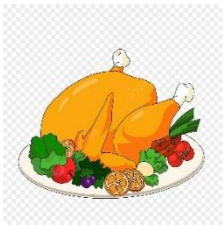

Columbus House 2026 Baby Bottle Fundraising Campaign: A reminder to those who took home baby bottles, the campaign ends next weekend on Father's Day. Filled bottles should be returned to the bins at the back of the church or dropped off at the office during office hours.

Petition to Support Bill C-218: On 20 June 2025, Private Member's Bill C-218 was introduced in the House of Commons. It proposes to repeal the planned 2027 expansion of the eligibility criteria for "Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD)," which would allow mental illness alone to qualify for euthanasia and assisted suicide. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) supports Bill C-218 and encourages the

Catholic faithful, in communion with their local Bishop, and all people of goodwill, to express their support for the same. There are petitions available at the church entrances for those who wish to support his bill. The petitions will be picked up after this weekend's masses so any intention to sign should happen no later than after the 5:15 mass on Sunday, June 14.
