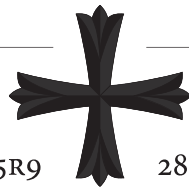

St. Columbkille (or St. Columbcille or St. Columba). The meaning is “dove of the Church” is our patron. An Irishman who went to Scotland. Born 7 December 521, he established a monastery on the Isle of Iona which became a base for the conversion of the people of Scotland. He died on the 9th of June 597. He is the patron saint of floods, bookbinders and poets.

Note: The bishop will celebrate Mass on the Solemnity of St. Columbkille this Tuesday. There will be adoration and vespers for the feast of the Sacred Heart. As adoration will be in the evening, there will be no adoration this Friday.

The month of the Sacred Heart: June is dedicated to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. In the Lord’s heart we find the love that has been given to us by God through the Passion, Death, Resurrection, and Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Feast of the Sacred Heart is **Friday, June 12th**. Vespers for the Sacred Heart will be held at 5:00 pm at the Cathedral with Exposition and Adoration beginning at 4:00 pm. At this time we will also pray the Act of Consecration to the Sacred Heart.

Corpus Christi Procession: After the Mass today, at the 10:30 am Mass, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament will occur in the cathedral. Benediction will follow the procession.

Petition to Support Bill C-218: On 20 June 2025, Private Member's Bill C-218 was introduced in the House of Commons. It proposes to repeal the planned 2027 expansion of the eligibility criteria for "Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD)," which would allow mental illness alone to qualify for euthanasia and assisted suicide. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB) supports Bill C-218 and encourages the Catholic faithful, in communion with their local Bishop, and all people of goodwill, to express their support for the same. There are petitions available at the church entrances for those who wish to support his bill.
