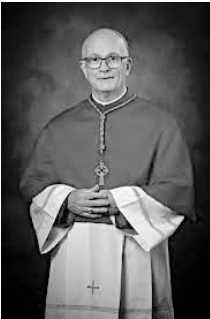

**Pope's Prayer Intention for July 2026: For respect for human life** – Let us pray for the respect and protection of human life in all its stages, recognizing it as a gift from God.

**Dedication of the Cathedral:** St. Columbkille Cathedral was dedicated on August 9<sup>th</sup>. This year, the solemnity of the Dedication falls on Sunday. This solemnity takes precedence over the Sunday of Ordinary Time. Your missals will not have the readings for this Sunday.

**Decoration Sunday** – The **Cemetery Memorial Service** will be held today, Sunday July 19<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm. You are encouraged to bring your own lawn chairs for this event. Plants and cut flowers are permitted on the graves for this occasion.

**Hymnals:** The Cathedral needs to purchase new hymnals. We will place a memorial in the cover for a deceased loved one. I will have envelopes available at the back for those who wish to help us and our music ministry here at St. Columbkille Cathedral.
