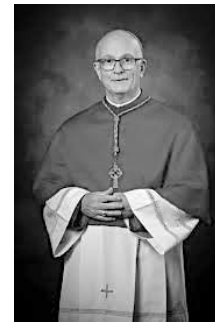

Dedication of the Cathedral: St. Columbkille Cathedral was dedicated on August 9th. This year, the solemnity of the Dedication falls on Sunday. This solemnity takes precedence over the Sunday of Ordinary Time. Your missals will not have the readings for this Sunday.

Next week, I will have envelopes available at the back for those who wish to help us and our music ministry here at St. Columbkille Cathedral.
